Hair Styles and Accessories

Boys

Labelling Uniform

All uniform must be labelled with the child's first initial(s) and surname.

- Shirts, tops, sweatshirts etc. should be labelled in the back of the neck
- Trousers, shorts, tracksuit bottoms etc. should be labelled in the back of the waistband
- Shoes should be labelled on the inside sole using a 'sharpie' or marker pen
- Bags, accessories, equipment and all other items should be labelled in a clear and obvious place to aid staff when lost items are handed in.
- Labelling items with a mark or symbol is not acceptable as it does not enable staff to identify the owner.
- Items that are handed in to the school office without an obvious name label are placed in the lost property basket for one week. After one week, unclaimed items are donated to the second hand uniform or a suitable charity.
